

## Job Description for Coordinator of Youth Ministries

The person in this position serves to develop, evaluate, and support our ministry with Middle and High School youth.

This includes:

- Will engage bible study, prayer and spiritual growth with High School and Middle School Youth Group Leaders (The High School Youth Group is called "In His Steps" and is usually referred to as IHS).
- Will support and attend Middle School and IHS meetings and events throughout/for the year.
- Will participate regularly in the Confirmation ministry (9<sup>th</sup> grade) in consultation with the Director of Discipleship
- Will support EGCC participation in ecumenical and missionary Youth Ministries (i.e. Emmaus, Head's Up Hartford) and coordinate a unified church calendar.
- Will develop and lead Youth Bible Study – specifically for youth in Grades 9 - 12

Qualifications: B.A. or equivalent life experience. Experience working with youth. Theological/Christian education, Biblical knowledge, and regular practice of spiritual disciplines.

Reporting: Hired and dismissed by Human Resources Ministry, reporting relationship with Senior Pastor, meets with Spiritual Formation Ministry and Director of Discipleship for support and coordination.

Hours: 8 per week averaged throughout the year (more during school year, less during the summer)
